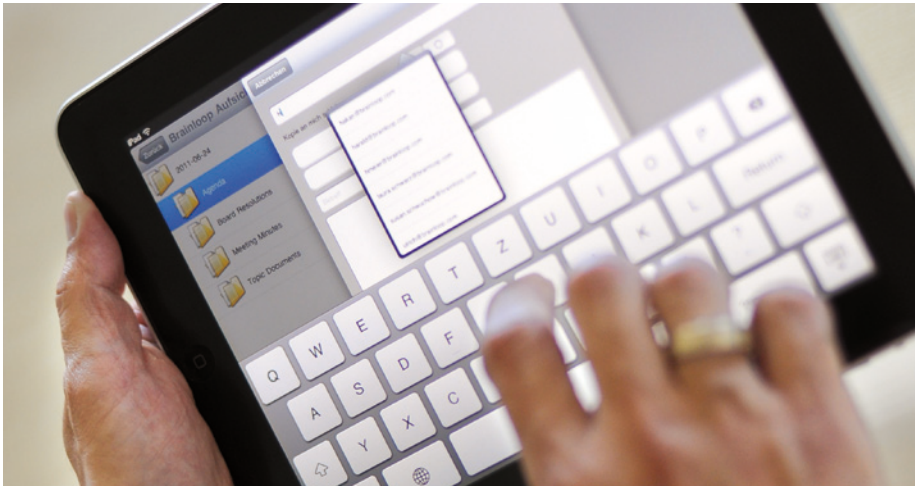

**Using Brainloop Mobile for the iPad, your confidential documents are always secure – whether you're preparing for a meeting on a plane or train, or getting some work done in an airport.**

Brainloop Mobile is an application that enables you to view and read confidential documents in your Brainloop Secure Dataroom using your iPad, as long as the data room has been configured to allow access from mobile devices.

With the appropriate document access permissions, you can download documents from the data room onto your iPad and read them offline, or use your iPad to send documents easily and securely via the data room.

Your confidential documents are further protected by Brainloop Mobile using an access code that you enter whenever you start the application. You may also need to authenticate yourself with a one-time PIN texted to your cell phone if your data room requires it.

All the documents you save locally are encrypted on the iPad independently from Apple's iOS encryption mechanism.

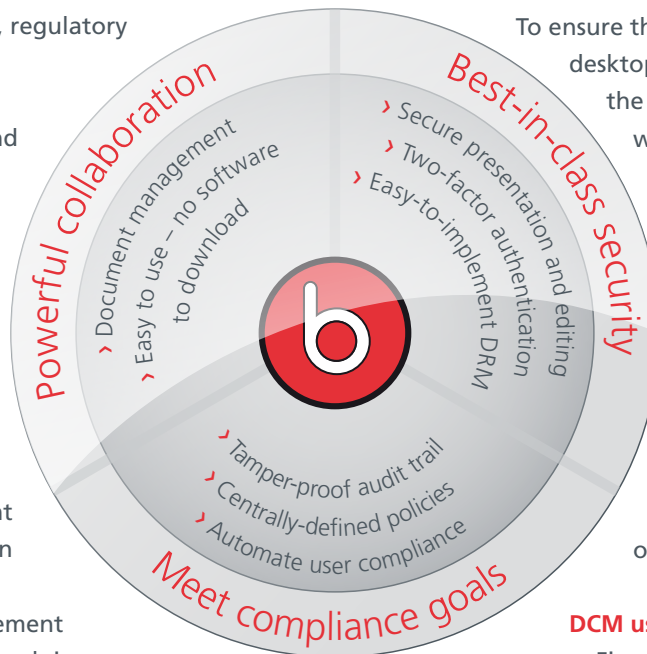

## Document Compliance Management by Brainloop

Strategic business activities, especially those where a lot of money or even the company's future is at stake, usually involve a lot of people who do not work for the company, or at least not directly. These may include external board members or consultants; partners interested in a joint venture; or, increasingly, regulatory authorities. This is why digital documents relevant to these processes cannot be kept behind the company's firewall, as they must be able to circulate securely among the authorized project participants. Many well-known security measures, such as encryption during transmission and on storage media, as well as enterprise-wide digital rights management systems, are only components in an overarching, integrated Document Compliance Management (DCM) strategy. The DCM approach is specifically designed for today's business dynamics, with their externally-focused activities. DCM systems require a high-security repository in which confidential documents are accessible to authorized project participants in accordance with their access rights. This high-security document repository must be easy to operate for non-IT staff, like management and board members, using a simple web browser.



Document Compliance Management covers the entire lifecycle of a document – from its creation through to its deletion – with no gaps. As a consequence, the document always remains under the system's watchful eye, even when it is opened, edited or stored on the desktop and also on mobile devices.

To ensure that it can be accessed from any desktop without installing client software, the DCM system is designed as a software-as-a-service (SaaS) solution. Also, management of the system's "keys" must be organized so that nobody – and especially not IT staff – can view and access content if they are not authorized to do so. A master key can be set up to cover emergency situations, but its administration should be divided between several people who each only own one part of the key.
